RE: GSA ALLIANT 2 GWAC SECTION G.25 ENVIRONMENTAL OBJECTIVES AND REQUIREMENTS

Salient CRGT is pleased to announce its' participation in the GWAC Environment Objectives and Requirements initiative to support Executive Order 13693. To reduce Greenhouse Gases, Salient CRGT's mission is to align with climate change resilience strategies, therefore, has taken the below steps to minimize energy consumption.

- Recycle – Electronic and paper waste recycling through a certified vendor
- Waste Reduction – Offices are equipment with filtered water stations to reduce the use of disposable plastic bottles, encouraging the use of personal water bottles
- Auto Light Controls – Offices are equipment with motion sensor auto light switches
- Reduction of Heat and Air Conditioning – Our offices are programmed to reduce the use of HVAC systems by changing the temperature during non-business core hours
- Relaxed Telework Policy – Salient CRGT encourages work from home for any non-essential on-site work. Salient CRGT has closed four offices in the past 5 months changing employees work location to home-based
- Public Transportation Benefits – Employees are offered pre-taxed benefits for public transportation

As Salient CRGT continues to expand its' workforce, facilities and Greenhouse Gas reduction will continued to be targeted and evaluated.
